CORPUS CHRISTI CELEBRATION



One of the many old-world traditions still celebrated at Good Samaritan Parish is the annual Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession. Following Mass, parishioners process through the church and out into the neighborhood. Each year a number of parishioners, including children, come dressed in colorful outfits worn in the country of their ancestors. The procession is led by a band, parishioners bearing flags from more than a dozen countries, and the Good Samaritan Choir. As the Eucharist is carried in procession, parishioners scatter flower petals along the path. Several years ago, I invited a friend from a Benedictine Abbey on Mount Zion in the Holy Land. He was amazed that we still keep this sacred tradition alive.
