From 2 Corinthians Chapter 5

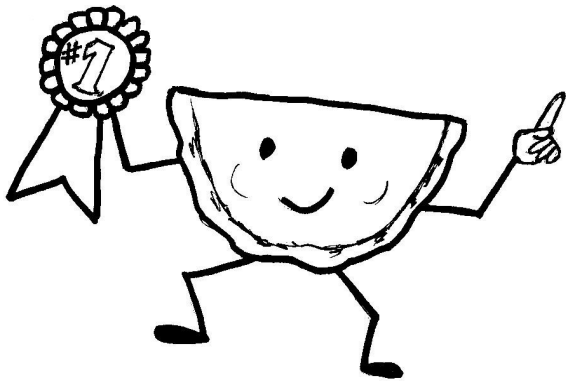

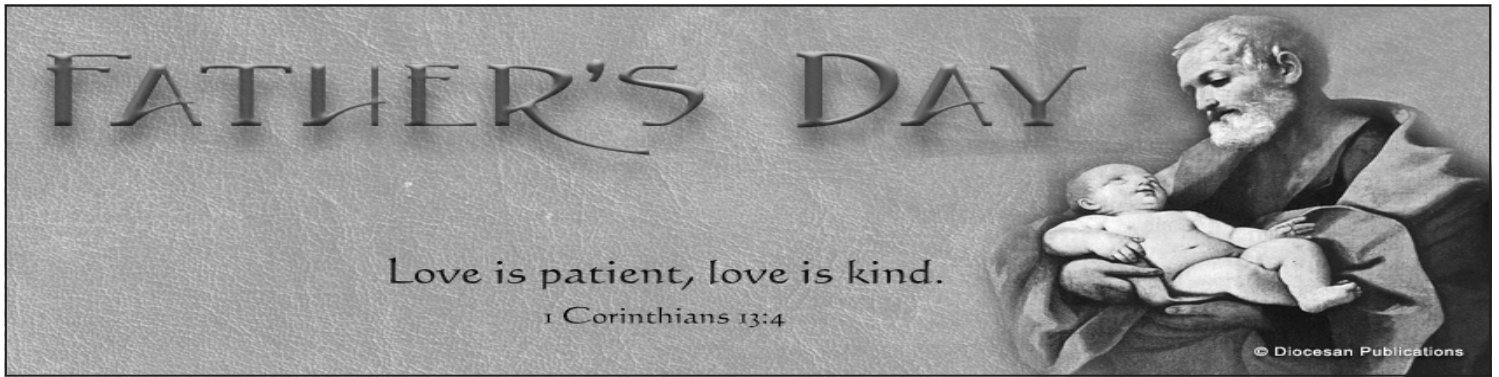
