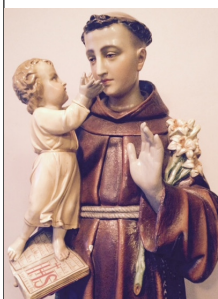
I hope to stop by the churches from time to time in the future. You have all had a huge impact on my life and vocation. I will pray for you all as I continue with my studies in Washington D.C.
