### From Father Joe

I am pleased to announce that we recently asked Chrystal Shelvey to join our staff at Good Samaritan as Director of Music & Liturgy. Chrystal has been assisting as organist at Good Samaritan and Saint John the Baptist for over 4 years, and has been acting Music Director for the past few months. I asked Chrystal to tell a little about herself.

*Sing to the LORD a new song;  
Sing to the LORD, all the earth.  
Sing to the LORD, bless His name;  
proclaim His salvation day after day.  
Tell His glory among the nations;  
Among all peoples,  
His marvelous deeds.*

These are the opening lines of Psalm 96. This is the Psalm that comes to mind at the opening of each Mass as you sing the Entrance Chant. I have been in many parishes and I have never heard a congregation sing with as much joy and enthusiasm as Good Samaritan. It touches my heart and turns my sights toward God.

It is an honor to come to the position as Director of Music & Liturgy at Good Samaritan Parish. I studied piano, organ and choral conducting at Wayne State University in Detroit and the University of Michigan. Knowing the power of music to touch hearts and minds, I majored in music therapy. I interned at Detroit Psychiatric Institute working with children and the elderly which I dearly loved. It was a new field and jobs were few and far between. I began a career in long-term care that kept me being with the elderly and still able to continue playing music.

I have been blessed with a wonderful husband and son. We moved to Pittsburgh from Asheville, NC in 2007 for my husband's new job. I was not a stranger to PA. My mother was born in Franklin and my father in Meadville and I had spent most of my summers here staying with relatives. In my "spare" time I love to garden and cook.

Music has been my life. It has taken me on many journeys from playing jazz with my husband, playing special songs at the bedside of a loved one that is about to die, or to sooth a child getting chemotherapy. It has all shown me that God gave us music to uplift our souls, to pray when we have no words, to join our voices together in praise and worship to our Lord.
